Below are suggestions for you to follow regarding supporting evidence in completing your Fellow application. Please understand the points you submit must have meaningful, supportive documentation. <u>To document points, at least</u> <u>ONE supporting document must be provided per category.</u>

Meeting Attendance

This section is automatically populated in your application based on the record of your attendance already at all Academy meetings. **Please note: in order to qualify for the Award of Fellow, you must have attend BOTH the Postgraduate Seminar and Annual Meeting during the THREE YEARS previous to applying.** EXAMPLE: If you apply in 2016, you must have attended at least one spring and one fall meeting within 2015, 2014 and 2013.

Section A - AOAO Positions and Committee Activity

You may document your volunteer activity the following ways:

- Copies of conference or seminar pamphlets that list your participation
- Search for lectures you may have given online at <u>http://www2.aoao.org/members/protected/lecture_search.iphtml</u>. You can print screen and save as a document (control P, then print).
- Copies of certificates of participation

B - American Osteopathic Board of Orthopedic Surgery (AOBOS)

• Contact the AOBOS office and they will have supporting documentation for your oral, clinical exams or item writing committee participation

Part C - Publications

• Copies of the title page of your authorship, or the entire article

Part D - Scientific Display

- Letter from a physician verifying participation
- Brochure documentation listing your poster
- Copy of poster acceptance letter

Section E – Lectures

- Copy of the conference program listing you as the speaker
- Copy of speaker letter supporting your presentation

Section F - AOA

• Documentation from the AOA supporting volunteer involvement

Section G - State Osteopathic Association

• Contact your State Osteopathic Association for documentation of your participation.

Section H - Education

- Documentation listing the residents or preceptors that you trained
- Letter from the medical school or hospital verifying your participation

I - Local Hospital

• Letter from hospital verifying your activity

We do understand some hospitals no longer exist, but usually you can find an official that can document your participation.

J - Community and State

• Reference letter or pamphlet from an official regarding your community or team physician participation

K – District Academy

• Letter from official within academy confirming participation, if you have points in this category

L – Special Consideration

You may submit your curriculum vitae and/or other notes that you feel may be significant in consideration of your application.

Other Committees

You may include a letter or brochure documenting your participation.
