Our standard protocol during any increase in influenza or other viruses is to increase the frequency of cleaning. In addition to following our usual high standards, and all SNHD and CDC protocols, Station Casinos has:

- Increased cleaning protocols to include more frequent disinfecting and wiping of touch points in our facilities such as door handles, elevator buttons, handrails and restrooms.
- Additional hand sanitizer stations have been strategically placed throughout our facilities.
- We have increased the outside air intake/air change rates during peak business periods.
- Reinforced with our Team Members best health practices including encouraging employees to stay home if they are sick or demonstrate health symptoms that could impact fellow colleagues or our guests.
- Reinforced with our Team Members all food safety standards including hand washing, and making hand sanitizer stations available throughout Team Member work areas.
